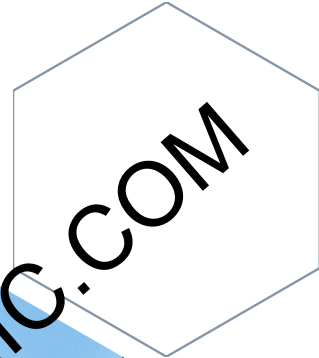

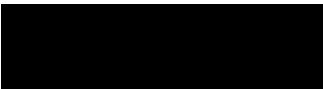

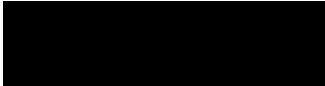


Enhancing your Performance

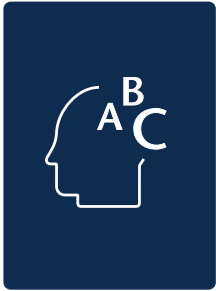


Enhancing your Performance

Find articles about studies or surveys in a topic that interests you. Analyse the diagrams and tables presented and try to make your own interpretation of the key findings. Read the text of the article to compare your interpretation to that of the authors.

- Look for opportunities to support your views with data. Practice creating clear, succinct arguments based around numerical information. In particular, try to summarise complex data in ways that are understandable to others who are not familiar with the data.
